

## Mary Evelyn Vineyard

We began farming Mary Evelyn in 2017. It was planted in 2004 to two distinct parts. The extreme south aspect is producing primarily Rhone red varietals while the extreme east (cooler) exposure is producing Riesling, Viognier and Pinot Gris.
