This is not your uncle's green bell pepper, obnoxiously herbaceous Cab Franc. This is Copeland Cab Franc-warm and rich and elegant. Sweet aromatics of peanut brittle and caramel with the slightest touch of anise hint at what's to come in the glass-turbinado sugar, bourbon and a muddled Luxardo cherry. Solid acid and a lingering finish make this perfect for those lively dinner party conversations that extend well past a reasonable bedtime.
