Tasting Notes

Aromas of coffee, dark fruit, and cedar combine with flavors of dark berry, currant, charred oak and velvety tannins and a lingering finish.

Alcohol: 13.9% pH 3.63

Aging: 22 months in French and American oak, 55% new

Harvested: October 21 and 29, 2013

Cases: 635

Varietal Breakdown: 82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 3% Syrah, 2% Malbec

Vineyards: 99% Copeland Vineyard, 1% Schmidt Vineyard
